The WPVA has been established to promote the development of pole vaulting at all ages and abilities (minimum age approx 13 years). Training sessions usually take place in the National Indoor Athletics Centre (NIAC) at UWIC, Cyncoed and are supervised by fully qualified pole vault coaches. Further details of time and venue can be obtained from any of the people named above.

Members are required to pay the annual £30 membership fee in addition to the normal “pay and play” entrance fee for NIAC.

For newcomers to pole vault, try it out for a few sessions, the first membership fee need only be paid one month after starting. You will not be required to provide any special equipment. Just turn up with trainers, spikes and enthusiasm and we will provide the rest!
